

Dear Students and Families,

I'm sorry I wasn't at school on Friday to help students prepare for the school shutdown – I had to leave for an out-of-town family occasion. As a result, some students took home lots of books (!), while others left everything here at school! I hope your families are staying healthy and able to take care of this situation over the next few weeks.

Students, use the extra time for reading and math practice – **keep your brains sharp!** (It feels weird not to have school for 3 weeks!)

The Superintendent of the Catholic Schools had recommended that students “work at home” for at least three days per week. This packet includes reading, writing, and math; also, there are pages to do in the social studies Simple Solutions book. Everything is due April 4.

Day 1: Read Sea Turtles book and complete the yellow worksheets.

Math: Problem-solving applications “packet”

Spelling: Word Sort for lesson 20; note that the word list is at the bottom of the page

Day 2: Re-do or complete any “R” pages that are in your packet

Math: Equivalent fractions and Factors worksheets

Spelling: do the “ladders” on the back of the math worksheets

Roll and Write a Story: use dice to pick a setting, a character, and plot --- write a COMPLETE,  
FINISHED STORY

Day 3: Simple Solutions Social Studies: lessons 80 and 81 (pages 160 – 163)

Study math facts, especially multiply and divide

It's My Party reading sheet: follow the directions for selecting your questions. Write in FULL,  
COMPLETE SENTENCES on notebook paper.

Day 4: Simple Solutions Social Studies: lessons 82 – 83 (pages 164 – 167)

Snow Day Fun reading sheet: follow the directions on the sheet; write in FULL, COMPLETE  
Sentences

Read your own chapter books!!!!!!!!!!!!

Day 5: Math: Fractions: lowest terms worksheet

Simple Solutions Social Studies: lessons 84 – 85 (pages 168 – 171)

Roll and Write a Story: use dice to pick a setting, a character, and a plot – write a COMPLETE, FINISHED STORY with those ideas.

**ALSO – complete your ART and GYM assignments for each day These are explained on the attached papers.**

**OPTIONAL** – play the “Over the Hill” math game with a partner

**STUDY LADDER is free** to use before 4:00 PM on school days. There are “assigned” tasks

For the 4<sup>th</sup> graders; the passwords are attached to this note.
